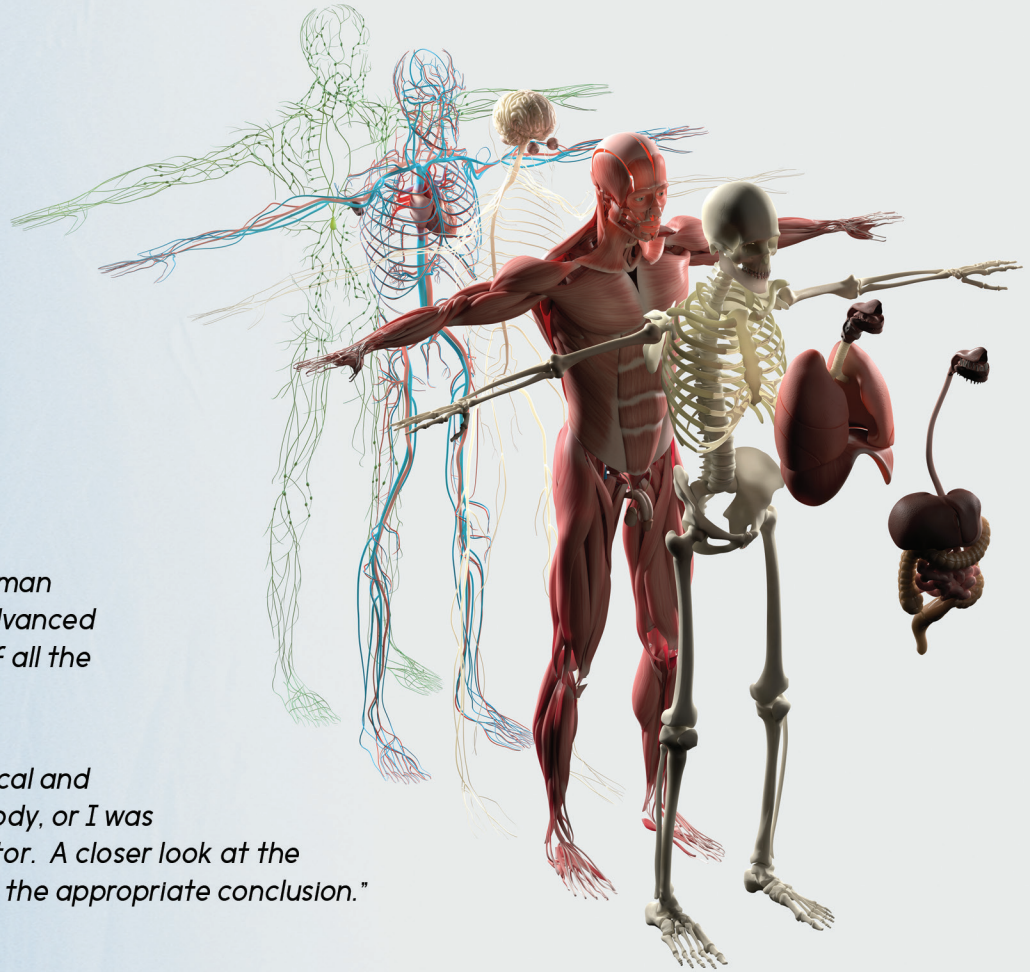

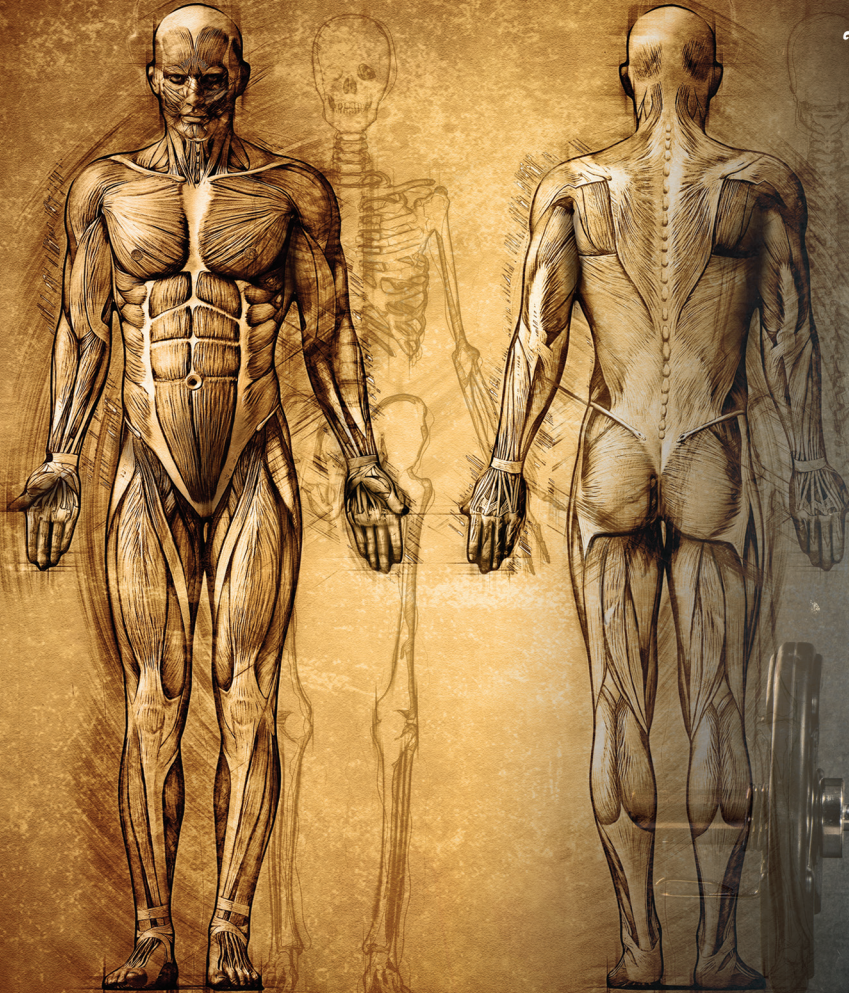

The Muscular System

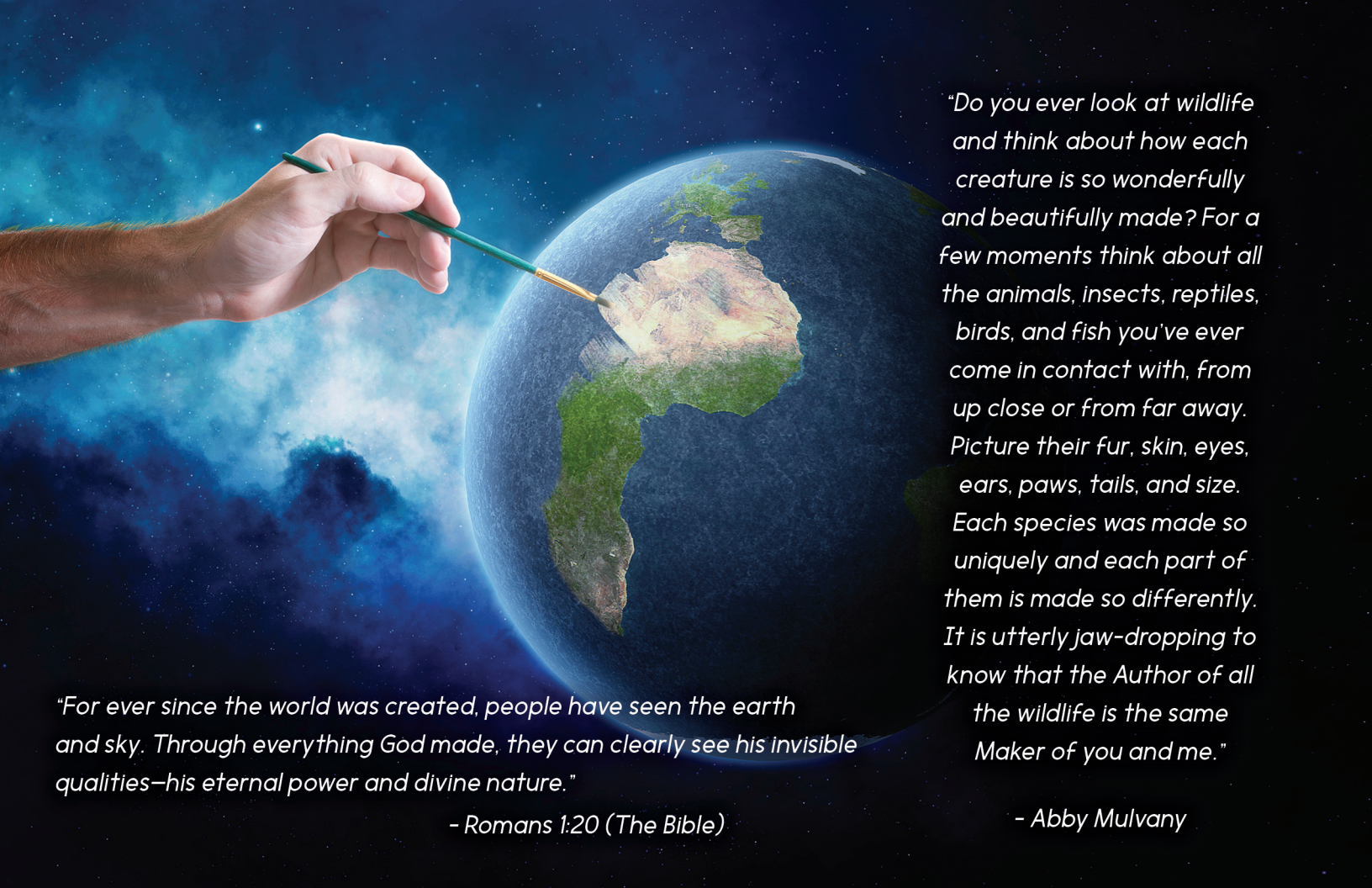




Shifting the index finger from one piano key or computer key to another requires little conscious effort, but such activity demands simultaneous processing of hundreds of thousands of electrical signals. Nerve cells within the spinal cord receive signals from sensors in the hand that detect motion, stretch, and position. This information, together with visual input from the eyes, enables the nervous system to make instant calculations about the finger's current position in space and immediately send new commands to multiple muscles to alter the finger's position.

Rufous hummingbirds hold the world record hummer migration distance. Each year they fly an unbelievable 3,900 miles from their wintering grounds in Mexico to their nesting grounds in Alaska or Canada! On these trips, they travel at an average speed of 30 mph (50 km/hr.) and consume as much as one-half their body weight in fuel per day. And their long tongues have pumps that lap up sugary nectar 23 times per second to keep their engines fueled and their hearts flutter at an astounding 1200 beats per minute.

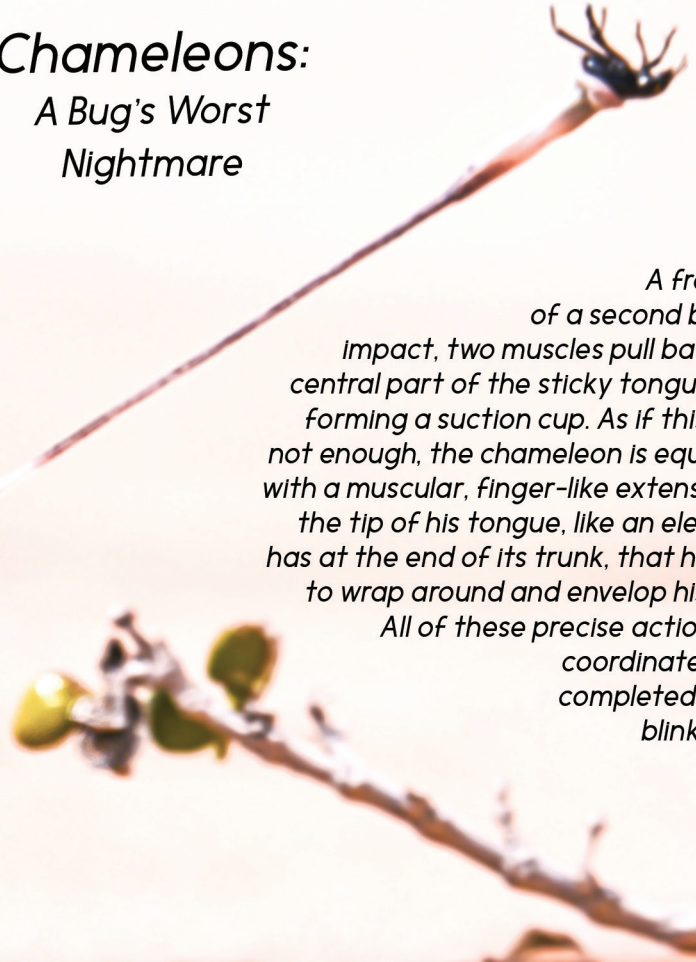

Chameleons: A Bug's Worst Nightmare

Zap! After he zeroes in, the chameleon quickly deals a deathblow with the ultimate bug-zapping weapon—a catapulting, grabbing tongue that accelerates five times faster than a fighter jet. Incredibly, he can project his tongue approximately twice his body length—roughly double the distance from the end of his snout to the base of his tail.

A fraction of a second before impact, two muscles pull back the central part of the sticky tongue pad, forming a suction cup. As if this were not enough, the chameleon is equipped with a muscular, finger-like extension at the tip of his tongue, like an elephant has at the end of its trunk, that he uses to wrap around and envelop his prey. All of these precise actions are coordinated and completed in the blink of an eye.
